
Crop Walk / 5th Sunday Service

We have been featuring the work of our excellent staff for several months now in our newsletter. Some have jobs that are easily visible, but others work behind the scenes to assist us in our fulfilling our mission to **Seek God, Love like Jesus** and **Serve the World.**



Our caretaker, Sam Morales, who has worked with us since 2011, is one of our staff that you may not see very much of, yet he is one who is responsible for seeing that the church building is ready for whatever it is we are doing. When you come to church on Sunday, to a meeting during the week or attend a potluck dinner, Sam is the one who makes sure that the rooms are unlocked, setup and cooled or heated for participants to use. This may seem simple, but it can actually be challenging to keep track of all that needs to be done. Sam accomplishes this while also doing outside work to support himself. He does his best to see that our building is ready to be used to support our mission and church life. 


