On Ash Wednesday, March 1, members of First Christian Church will have the opportunity to offer sacred space beyond the wall of our church with Ashes to Go. We will offer ashes on the corner of Euclid and Speedway, by the bus stop and in our parking lot. You are invited to take part, whether you are available for 30 minutes, 2 hours or longer! Last year we offered ashes to over 180 people as they stopped by our parking lot and the bus stop by our building. We encountered a variety of people. Some people had not been to church in years, but found comfort in the ancient faith practice. Some were active members of churches, but would not be able to make it to an Ash Wednesday service. They were grateful for the opportunity to receive ashes in the midst of a busy schedule. Others talked about their struggle with faith, organized religion, and finding a community in which they felt they could engage in that struggle. Ashes to Go was an unintimidating way to connect with their faith after so many years away from the church.



Through Ashes to Go, we affirm God's presence in the everyday business of our lives and that of our neighbors, even in the

midst of our humanity, fragility, and need for grace, repentance and forgiveness. Our hope and prayer is to create a space that invites those passing by into a time of prayer, pause, and blessing.

Staff Spotlight: Pastor Ailsa



We have been featuring the work of our excellent staff for several months now in our newsletter. This month we spotlight our Pastor, Rev. Ailsa Guardiola González

In February we celebrated Pastor Ailsa's fourth anniversary of being our minister at First Christian Church, Tucson. We are thankful for the many gifts and talents she brings to this ministry. She continues to support and inspire us in her quiet, loving and persistent way. In worship, she challenges us to think about scripture and experience God in new ways. She encourages us to take risks as we explore together what our mission is as a congregation in this time and place at FCC, in order that we might live in faith as we seek to follow the way of Jesus.

Pastor Ailsa is skilled in helping us discern what it means to be church in the 21st century. She earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Child and Family Development from the University of Georgia and went on to Duke Divinity School where she received her Master of Divinity. She served as an Associate Pastor at the First Christian Church in Wilmington for seven years where her work focused on spiritual formation for children, youth and adults

and outreach. Ailsa also served with Global Ministries as a missionary in Honduras and El Salvador where she met her husband Marco. When she came to Tucson, she shared those experiences which led to the El Salvador Mission Trip in November 2015.

Pastor Ailsa continues to be involved with Disciples Regional and National leadership projects such as the Regional Mission Focus team and Congregational Vitality team, the XPLOR program, and serving on the Disciples Seminary Foundation Board. She also participates in local mission and ecumenical programs with shared leadership among other area ministers. And she pursues training to enhance her ministry. One of her strengths is how she works collaboratively to build partnerships with staff, within our congregation and with others in our community so that we can work together. She is able to listen and respond compassionately while encouraging us to use our spiritual gifts to build bridges instead of divisions. We give thanks for Pastor Ailsa, her husband Marco and daughter Krysia and look forward to what our future will be as we strive to "Seek God, Love like Jesus and Serve the World."

The church celebrates Mental Health Sundays, church leaders have shared their experience with mental health challenges, Ailsa speaks about mental health in her sermons, and prayers are lifted up every week. You have not only broken the silence around mental health issues, but also have affirmed people affected as elders and deacons. You are a model for other churches.

I have been working with a team of people who give me support, guidance and advice. This group includes: Ailsa Guardiola González, Lori Bryant, Ann Nichols, Rudy Byrd, Susan Harris, Nancy DeArman, and Paul DeArman. I appreciate their wisdom and experience and others like Shirley Gale who are available to help as well.

We have a Spiritual Support Group for people and family affected by mental health challenges meeting twice a month on Monday evenings, and between 5 to 11 people have been attending. Because I am now retired and will be able to focus more energy into the ministry, we are adding two more group times. The following Spiritual Support Groups will meet in March in the Parlor:

1st & 3rd Mondays 6:00 – 7:30 PM 2nd & 4th Wednesdays 3:00 – 4:30 PM

Also, in late March, Susan Harris and I will be going to a National Benevolent Association retreat at Picture Rocks to learn how to best do this ministry.
