Forward Together: Process of Christian Spiritual Discernment Saturday, May 12, 9:00am-Noon

Forward Together. This is how we envision our congregation's future. To whatever God calls us. To where ever God says go. For however God says, "Share my love." We listen, are equipped, and act together as a

community united in the spirit of God. For this reason, we pray that each person actively participating within our congregation join in our process of Christian spiritual discernment that begins on Saturday, May 12 at 9:00am-Noon.

Why a process of Christian spiritual discernment, and what is that anyway?

Our first session will address these questions more fully, but most simply put, Christian spiritual discernment is **intentionally seeking God's desire through practices of prayer and deep reflection from the riches of our Christian tradition**. Our facilitators will teach us the principles and guide the process, so you do not need any special skills or knowledge to participate.

We are using this process, because as a community of faith we are much more than a group of people capable of democratic decisions. We are God's people – the body of Christ – and have the gift of the Holy Spirit. Because this is not just Sunday morning talk, we seek to live these truths together. Therefore, we will intentionally seek God, learn new ways to hear and listen to God, trust God, and as a result grow as a congregation and as individuals together.

What does this process look like?

We will be led by Rev. Teresa Blythe and Greg Essenmacher (teresablythe.net), who

Childcare will be provided.

Our goal by the final session is to come to an agreement on concrete questions about our mission and building, including action steps for living it out.

The changing landscape of our society and world presents us with new opportunities for reaching others and sharing God's love and hope in our community. I look forward to exploring these with all of you as we trust in a future upheld by God, grounded in Christ's love, and infused by the Spirit.

Helpful Hints for Giving



In addition to the ministry and mission that it provides, one of the personal benefits of giving to the church is the credit or deduction that one can apply to their taxes. In order to make use of this, please follow these steps:

- If using checks, make sure to write the reason for the gift on the memo line of the check and/or place the check in an envelope and clearly indicate the reason for the gift on the envelope.
- If giving for more than one purpose, write a separate check for each.
- o If using cash, put the cash in an envelope; <u>clearly print your name on the envelope and indicate the reason for the gift(s) on the envelope.</u>

These same steps will greatly help the bookkeeper and treasurer to appropriately document your gifts and direct them as you intend. Thank you!
