Pastor's Note

"We look with uncertainty" by Anne Hillman

We look with uncertainty beyond the old choices for clear-cut answers to a softer, more permeable aliveness which is every moment at the brink of death; for something new is being born in us if we but let it.

We stand at a new doorway, awaiting that which comes... daring to be human creatures, vulnerable to the beauty of existence. Learning to love.



The passing of time is a curious thing. It happens without us really noticing...tick-tock, tick-tock...until we do notice. A birthday. Anniversaries of different sorts. A new year. On and on it goes, tick-tock, never ceasing. In the end, where does it get us? Where does it lead us? It is typical at the start of a New Year for people to take an account of their lives, to reflect on where the last year has taken them, and to dream and express hopes for what is to come. But one thing for which we can be certain is that we have no certainty of what is to come. What experiences of joy, what hardships, what surprises await us?

I find Anne Hillman's poem to be filled with incredible beauty as it encourages us to embrace uncertainty as a gift for our future. Beyond fixed answers, where does the imagination of the prophets, of Zechariah, of John the Baptist, and of Mary—that we have lived with through the Advent and Christmas seasons— lead us? Of what do we need to let go to experience "aliveness?" As we move on from celebrations of a new baby, what new thing is wanting to be born in us? Are we willing to stand in new doorways, "daring to be...vulnerable to the beauty of existence," daring to learn to love something or someone new?

We cannot know what the future holds for sure. But we are people of faith, people of the God who is faithful and steadfast in love. We go forward in this new year, witnessing to the presence of God in our lives and strengthening one another to be ever-open to the new paths before us.
